11. Direct & Indirect Speech	Indirect and indirect speech of all tenses. Direct speech into indirect speech conversion. Indirect to direct speech conversion
12. Error Detection	Pointing out errors from passages and sentences based on punctuation, grammatical errors and spelling mistakes

13. Sentence Arrangement	Choosing appropriate word to complete a sentence, re-arranging words to form a meaningful sentence
14. Fillers	Single and para fillers
15. Synonyms & Antonyms	At least three synonyms and antonyms of given words
16. One Word Substitutions	Study, terms, collection, people, profession, science, sound and sports related one-word substitutions
17. Idioms & Phrases	Meaning of commonly used idioms and their appropriate use in sentences. Noun, verb, and prepositional phrases
