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Answers with Hints

- **1.** (d) Penguin, kiwi and ostrich are flightless birds except pigeon it can fly, hence, pigeon is the odd one among all.
- **2.** (b) Nail, coin and spoon will sink in water, while plastic toy will float on water surface because plastic has less density than water.
- **3.** (a) Lack of rain or no rain for longer period of time causes drought.
- 4. (c) Full Moon will be seen in IV phase. As, I is waning crescent, II is last quarter and III is waning gibbous.
- **5.** (a) The Earth atmosphere contains 78% of nitrogen gas, 21% of oxygen gas and 1% other gases Hence, nitrogen is most abundent gas in Earth atmosphere.
- **6.** (b) A Mechanic repairs vehicles like bikes, cars, etc. with his tools such as screw driver, spanners, etc. Keshav's father is going to a mechanic.
- 7. (a) Eagles and vultures are birds of prey, i.e. they eat mice, frog, snakes, chicks, etc.
